How to get to the Dean's Office?

The Queue Management System located next to room no. 19 will issue a ticket to the right office.

You can receive the Student ID - the most important document confirming your status as a student - in the Teaching Quality and Student Services Office. Your Student ID is also a library card, it enables you to use public transportation tickets and discounts.

The expiry date of the Student ID is encoded in the chip and also in the hologram that needs to be changed each semester after passing the exams.

The holograms are issued by the Teaching Quality and Student Services Office:

- **after the winter semester - up to March 31,**
- **after the summer semester - up to October 31.**

You can get the duplicate of your Student ID in case you lose it.

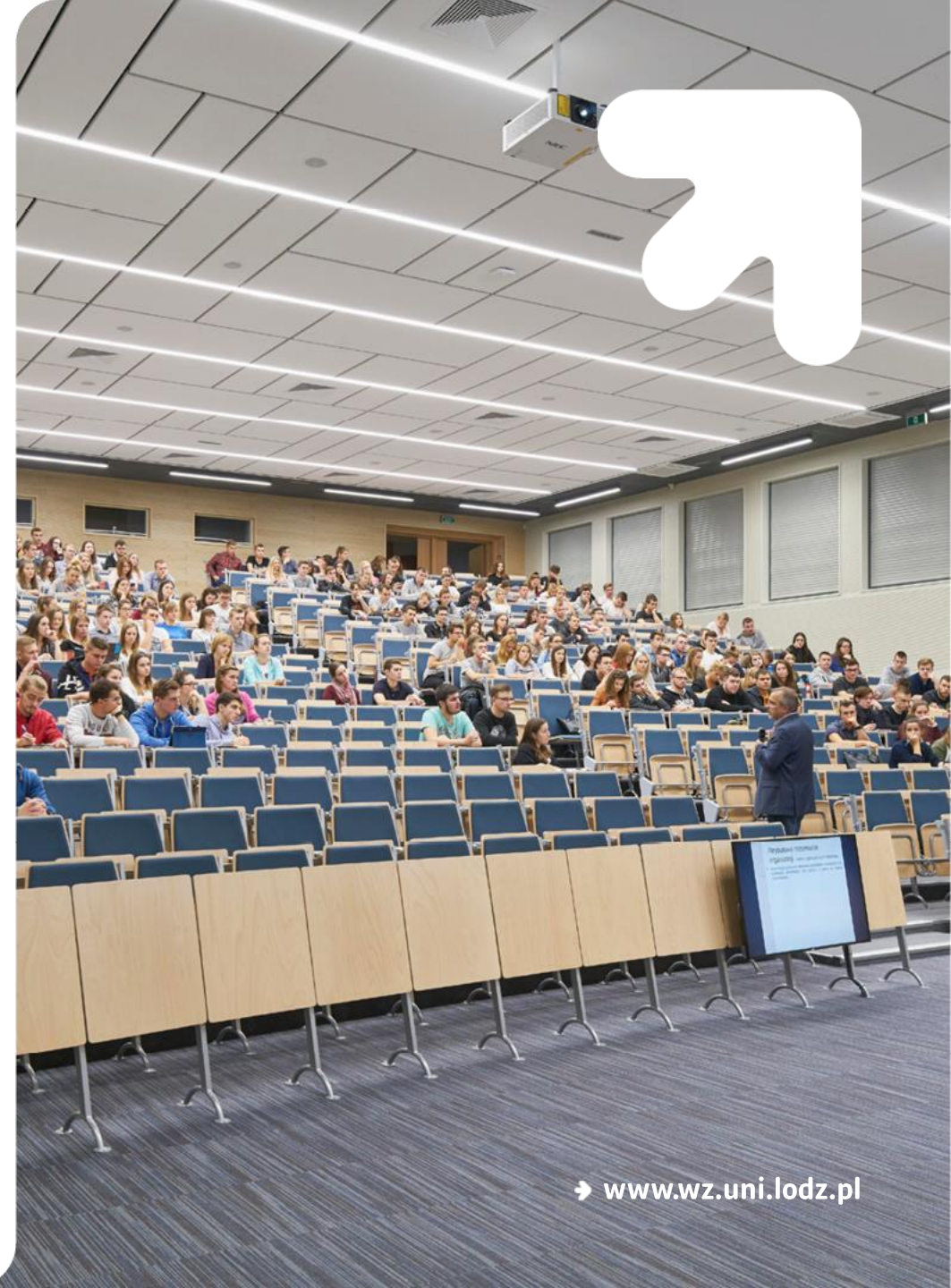
WHAT AND WHERE

How to read labels of the rooms:

- Floor -1 – labels include double zero (e.g. room 001, room 002)
- Floor 0 – labels do not include 0 (e.g. room 1, room 2)
- Labels on floor 1 are numbered 101+, on floor 2 – 201+, on floor 3 – 301+

Lecture halls:

- Lecture hall A – the main lecture hall, called also Prof. Zieleniewski's Lecture Hall, entrances on floor 0
- Lecture hall A0 – entrances on floor -1
- Lecture hall A1 – entrances on floor +1

Faculty's library:

You can find the library on floor 0 – corridor to the left from the main entrance.

The library account can be activated by visiting the UL Library in person. It is also possible to set up the account online - in order to do that, you need to use your official university e-mail address and send a message to bul.wm@lib.uni.lodz.pl. You will get the answer with the instructions. In order to use the book lending machine („Książkomat”) you need to authorize your library card/student ID in the UL Library.

Wi-Fi:

You can use the Wi-Fi in the building. In order to get the access, follow the instructions on this website: [Internet na Wydziale](#): firstly, you need to activate your Active Directory account and next you can access the eduroam network.

Canteen:

Happy Mix Food – student restaurant offering buffet style meals. You can find the entrance on floor -1, corridor next to the cloak room.

ACADEMIC YEAR 2023/2024 - CALENDAR

I semester (winter)

1st semester lasts from 1 October 2023 to 25 February 2024

Didactic classes start on 3 October 2023 and last until 28 January 2024.

Days off from the didactic classes are, as follows:

- 31 October 2023 – the Rector's day,
- 2 November 2023 – the Rector's day,
- from 22 December 2023 until 7 January 2024 – winter holiday break,
- from 12 to 18 February 2024 – break between the semesters.

Examination sessions in the winter semester take place on the following dates:

- from 29 January to 11 February 2024 – winter examination session,
- from 19 to 25 February 2024 – winter make-up examination session.



II semester (summer)

2nd semester lasts from 26 February to 30 September 2024

Didactic classes start on 26 February and last until 16 June 2024.

Days off from the classes are, as follows:

- from 27 March to 2 April 2024 – Easter holiday break,
- 2 May 2024 – the Rector's day,
- one May Friday – might be declared the Rector's day due to Juwenalia (students' festival),
- 24 May 2022 – the Rector's day due to the Celebration Day of the University of Lodz,
- 31 May 2023 – the Rector's day.

Examination sessions in the summer semester take place on the following dates:

- from 17 June to 7 July 2024 – summer examination session,
- from 8 July until 30 September 2024 – break for summer holidays, scientific camps, internships, etc.,
- dates of final assessments and examinations during autumn examination session taking place in September are determined by the Dean.

MS OFFICE – NEW ACCOUNTS



All students will be provided with new accounts @edu.uni.lodz.pl. The users will get the following benefits:

- possibility of using the extended Microsoft Office 365 Professional Plus package, which can be installed on up to 15 private devices (5 computers, 5 tablets and 5 phones)!
- you will get 2 terabytes (TB) of OneDrive storage space
- the technical problems associated with online classes will be significantly reduced (you will no longer be a “guest” on Teams platform).

Setting up the new accounts is in progress, each student will receive a message. In case of any problems, please contact the Teaching Quality and Student Services Office.

DISTANCE LEARNING - TOOLS



e-Campus platform (Moodle)

The main tool supporting distance learning in the University of Łódź. All lecturers and students have their own accounts. This software guarantees a safe distribution of teaching materials - presentations, articles, scripts, recordings, links. It allows lecturers to create and share courses, tests and communicate with the students (grades, discussion forums, tasks, tests).

Microsoft Teams

The centre of teamwork in the Office 365 services and the main tool for having "live" online classes. It provides tools and services enabling the teamwork via chat, meetings and calls. Everyone having a university e-mail can access it.

OTHER INTRODUCTORY INFORMATION



eCampus (Moodle) – University's distance learning software. It offers tools for student-teacher communication. In order to use it, you need to have an USOS account.

University e-mails – each student is provided with a student e-mail address (...@edu.uni.lodz.pl) which is a tool to communicate with other students, lecturers and employees. The account enables you to access UŁ helpdesk and allows for only one login and password to: e-mail, MS TEAMS, USOSWEB and WiFi in Eduroam network.

ECTS points – points representing the amount of work students need to pass various subjects and type of classes (lectures, workshops, seminars). Thanks to ECTS points European students have the opportunity to study in any school using the system and the time spent in another university can be fully accepted by the student's main university.

Mandatory training courses – shortly after starting your studies you need to take mandatory training courses:

- OSH – Occupational Safety and Health (Polish: BHP)
- Copyright course

These courses can be found on e-Campus platform and are held online.

University Study-Oriented System (USOSweb) – software collecting your grades and scholarships, enabling you to enroll into classes and modules as well as track your progress. After each semester you can fill in the forms evaluating your classes and lecturers. You may also download the mUSOS mobile app.
